Who is eligible?

- Supporters of Pastoral Counseling in the AAPC Southeast Region (Alabama, Florida, Georgia, North Carolina, South Carolina, Mississippi or Tennessee).

Preference for scholarship awards is given in the following order:

- **Students** (those individuals still enrolled in a seminary, divinity school or university counseling related Masters or Doctoral program) located in the AAPC Southeast Region states (Alabama, Florida, Georgia, North Carolina, South Carolina, Mississippi or Tennessee).
- **Associates** – Defined as those who have graduated from a theological or counseling-related Masters or Doctoral program AND who are currently under supervision and working toward certification and/or licensure in a pastoral counseling or mental health related discipline (ie...psychology, professional counseling, marriage & family therapy, social work, etc...).
- **Female and minority ethnicity** certified and/or licensed professionals in pastoral counseling and/or other mental health related disciplines

Scholarship Amounts:

Scholarships are designed to cover all or a portion of the Conference *Registration Fee* – The scholarship does NOT cover any portion of lodging and meals. Applicant will be notified of the award in a timely manner.
